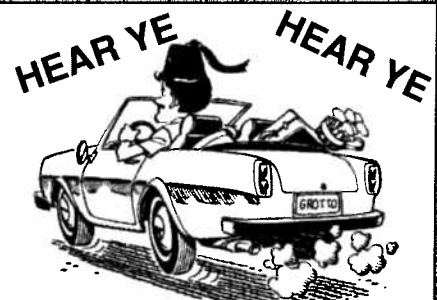
## SICK & DISTRESSED

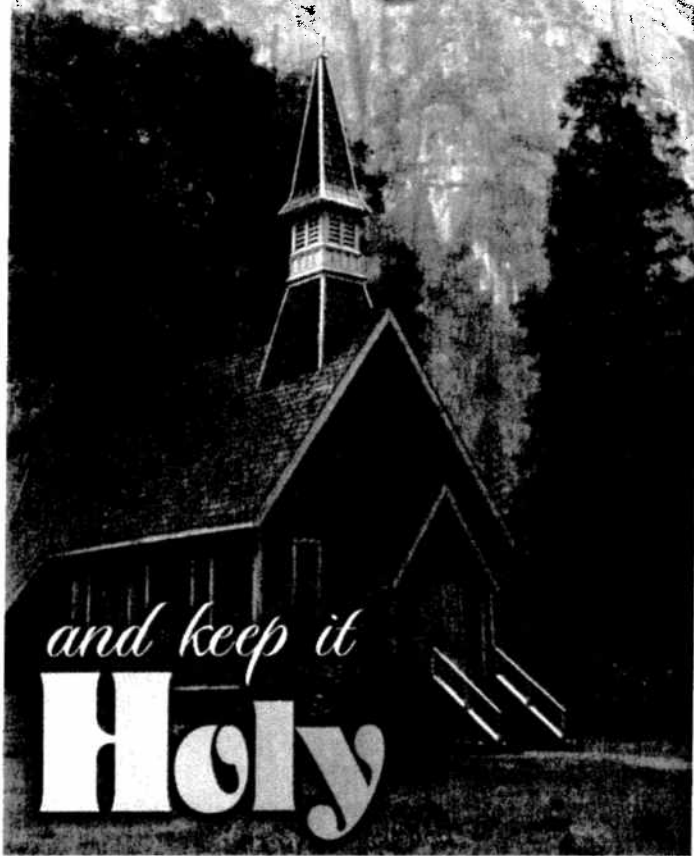

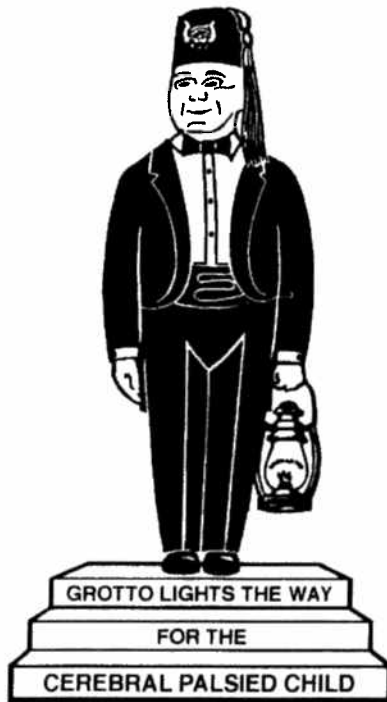

## LAKE COUNTY CAPTAINS BASEBALL

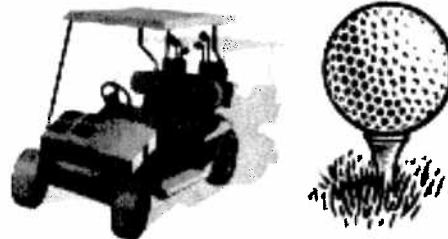
Al Sirat Grotto will be attending the **Saturday, June 27, 2009, Captains Baseball Game**. The Captains operation is very family oriented.

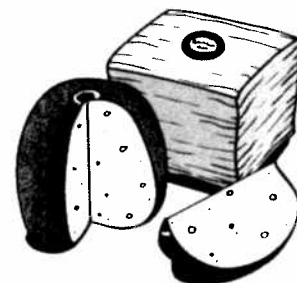
At the May Business Meeting, the body approved that Al Sirat Grotto would cover the expenses for the necessary upgrades to one of our CP Children's wheelchair.

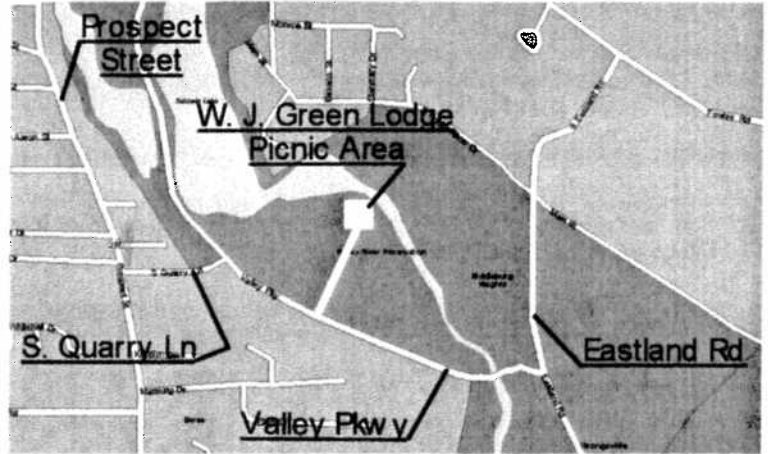
